### 1) How much does it cost to register my band for in-person registration?

## 5) How do I purchase tickets for my students for the Concert Series and Jazz Crawl?

## 9) What is the difference between competitive and non-competitive in the instrumental division?

a) Groups participating in the competitive class will have a sight reading component in addition to prepared pieces. Ensembles will also receive a score in their division class. Groups participating will not have sight reading and will not receive a score. All ensembles will receive adjudicator feedback.

#### 10) Do you recommend my school staying overnight?

a) Yes! Our festival offers a wide range of activities throughout the day on Friday and Saturday. Masterclasses will feature international-renowned musicians and clinicians. Both evenings, our Concert Series will feature our Guest Artists backed by GRAMMY-nominated UW-Eau Claire Jazz I. On Friday evening, we have the very popular Jazz Crawl in Eau Claire's downtown district featuring dozens of bands performing from 6pm to 2am.
